



## *Attention All Elite Amateur Golfers!*

The SouthCoast Four-Ball Tournament Committee welcomes your participation in the inaugural South Coast Four-Ball Championship, to be contested Saturday, April 23 and Sunday, April 24 at Allendale Country Club in North Dartmouth, Massachusetts. The 36-hole, two-person better ball stroke play tournament promises to feature championship conditions for leading amateurs throughout New England and beyond.

In launching the SouthCoast Four-Ball Championship, it is our aim to become a premier season-opening event for the New England competitive golf season in 2022, with elite amateur teams from throughout the region invited to compete.

Allendale CC is a 6,756 yard, par 72 parkland course, designed by Geoffrey Cornish in 1956. Course Superintendent Matt Medeiros and his crew are excited and well-prepared to bring outstanding tournament course conditions to Allendale and all SouthCoast Four-Ball competitors. The course will be prepared to present a fair and true championship test for the competition.

Head PGA professional Chris Jones has begun planning the execution of the event with the focus on providing a top-notch, memorable tournament for all competitors.

The tournament will feature two divisions. **The Championship Division format will be a Two Person Better Ball Stroke Play event and the competition is open to teams with a combined USGA GHIN Handicap Index of 8.0 and below.** In the Championship Division, players under 60 years will play the Championship Tees at approximately 6750 yards, while Seniors (60 years+) will play the White Tees at approximately 6,450 yards.

**The First Division format will be played as a Two-Person Better Ball Net Stroke Play event, using 80% of USGA Handicaps.** This division will compete from the White Tees, and is **open to teams with a combined USGA GHIN Handicap Index of 8.1 to 20.0.**

We look forward to welcoming you to the first annual SouthCoast Amateur FourBall at Allendale CC this April!
